

NURBURGRING 24 HOURS 2020

HOUR 9 REPORT - RAIN STOPS PLAY AT THE NORDSCHLEIFE





SP9 CLASS



Unrelenting rain at the Nürburgring overnight has seen the race red-flagged, with no chance of a restart before 7am local time (CEST), shortly after what would have been the 15th hour of competition in the event.

At the red flag, Christian Krognes was behind the wheel of the #101 car, and was in 13th overall in the BMW M6 GT3, while the #100 car had just been repaired and had rejoined the race but had barely had time to set a lap at the hands of Mario van Buhlen.









SP8T CLASS



In the SP8T class, Daniel Harper was still in control of the #73 BMW M4 GT4 and was running first in the class, and an impressive 26th overall, mixing it with the SP9 drivers.

The #74 was two laps further behind and was running fourth in class, with Ben Tuck having just taken over.

A decision on when and how to restart the race will come at 07:00 CEST.
